Bachelor of Education (Secondary Curriculum)

The professional year is the final component of your Bachelor of Education degree program. On successful completion of the professional year you'll be eligible for a BC teaching certificate (issued by the Ministry of Education's Teacher Regulation Branch) and the Bachelor of Education degree (awarded by UVic).

Will I qualify for a teaching certificate in another province?

The Agreement on Internal Trade enables labour mobility across Canada for all trades and professionals. If you qualify for a teaching certificate in British Columbia, you can expect to qualify for a teaching certificate in another province.

Where can I get information about tuition?

Tuition is based on a per-unit fee that varies from year to year. The 2017 rate will be announced in the spring. **Tip!** You will register in 13.5 units in professional year.
