

Supplemental / Deferred Exam Statement

The following statement should be read before students commence to write either a supplemental or deferred examination.

If students are writing a DEFERRED exam read the following:

If you are writing a deferred exam and you choose to leave the exam now before opening the exam materials, then you will have your current DEF grade changed to an N grade. (An N grade is a fail grade and you will be blocked from registration in any course for which the N graded course is a prerequisite.)

If students are writing a SUPPLEMENTAL exam read the following:

If you are here to write a supplemental exam and you choose to leave the exam now before opening the exam materials, then there will be no recording of this event on your permanent record. Only the original E grade from the original course failure will appear on your transcript.

On the other hand, if you open the exam materials, a supplemental exam mark will be posted on your record. Supplemental exams cover only the course work covered by written final examinations. The supplemental exam grade replaces the grade of the course final exam and has the same weight as that of the final exam. Any passing grade obtained on a supplemental exam will be shown on the student's academic records with a grade point value of 1, corresponding to a D, and will be treated according to University Regulations for supplemental exams.

If you wish to withdraw from writing the exam, please bring your examination materials to the invigilator and leave the exam room now.
