## SUMMARY OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

To serve as teaching assistant for ADMN 311 A01/A02 & POLI 350. This is a single online course, with all students accessing content through the same Brightspace course site, offered by the School of Public Administration.

Duties will include: assist the professor in synthesizing student weekly postings; assisting with grading assignments; other relevant duties as assigned by instructor.

Course Title and description: ADMN 311/ POLI 350 - Introducation to Public Administration An exploration of the external factors affecting contemporary public sector management in Canada, the changing structural and value context within which public servants work, the key processes in which they are engaged and how those processes are changing. Focus is primarily on the federal and provincial governments. Discusses municipal administration and Indigenous governance.

## REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE:

Priority for hiring will first be given to graduate students enrolled in a School of Public Administration program, in accordance with CUPE 4163 comp.1 Appendix A Appointment Priority Policy or LOU # TA 1.

- Completion of ADMN 311/ POLI 350 and/ or ADMN 504 (or equivalent) with a grade of A- or higher.
- Superior written communication skills and ability to constructively critique students' assignments.
- Familiarity with Brightspace is an asset.
- Experience as a teaching assistant is an asset.
