JOB DESCRIPTION: The Students of Colour Collective (SOCC) is a constituency group of the UVSS. We organize and promote anti-racism and anti-colonial activism at UVic, and collaborate with other student groups, community groups/organizations who function under similar or complementary mandates.

The resource coordinator will:

- Work independently with the guidance of the collective and collective coordinator to plan and produce communication/resource materials for SOCC.
- Act as main contact between Uvic students of colour population and the collective.
- Develop outreach materials such as posters, pamphlets and buttons.
- In collaboration with SOCC members, especially with the SOCC project coordinator, organize other opportunities for outreach and promotion.
- Coordinate and collaborate with the SOCC project coordinator to produce a zine or other creative publication which includes calling out for submissions—articles, art, poetry—editing and ad layout, as well as distribution.
- Assist in Coordination and Collaboration of updating and maintaining the SOCC library, and shared garden plot with the UVic Pride Collective

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Demonstrated anti-racist/anti-oppressive perspective and analysis (i.e. What does anti-racism look like to you?).
- Demonstrated commitment to reproductive justice* (including an understanding of how reproductive justice issues manifest in communities of colour)
- Ability to self-locate (i.e. recognize sites of privilege and oppression).
- Ability to work within the consensus decision-making model.
- Demonstrated ability to be self-motivated and take initiative.
- Ability to organize, prioritize and follow through with planned tasks, being flexible with multiple work styles.
- Work well in a multi-purpose office setting (i.e. SOCC is a social and work space for students of colour)
