- Minimum averages fluctuate every year, therefore students are encouraged to apply if they meet the minimum published requirement (see University of Victoria Undergraduate Calendar).
- Year One entry to Business, Fine Arts (Music, Theatre or Visual Arts) and Health Information Science requires supplementary materials, such as questionnaires, auditions and portfolio submissions.
- Possession of the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission to any faculty, program or course and cutoffs may be higher during self-reporting. In those instances where the number of qualified applicants exceeds the number that can be accommodated, the minimum averages required for admission will be higher than those published.
