#### DERRICK & GWEN MALLARD SCHOLARSHIP IN ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

A scholarship of \$1,000 is awarded to a student in a declared Major or Minor in Environmental Studies with a record of contribution to the protection of the environment. **\*Additional Documents:** Résumé, a brief essay (1-2 pages) expanding on your contribution to protect the environment. **DEADLINE:** April 30<sup>th</sup>

#### GEORGIA KLAP AWARD

One or more awards are given to students who are entering the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year of a declared Major in Environmental Studies or students in the Restoration of Natural Systems Diploma program. Preference will be given to students who are entering a field school or field course. **\*Additional Documents:** A letter of application demonstrating a commitment to environmental and social change, a passion for experiential learning and a passion for sharing these interests and values with others. The donors would enjoy receiving a letter (submitted to the department) upon completion of the term to learn what the award and the experience meant to the recipient. This may be used for online or printed communication materials. **DEADLINE:** April 30<sup>th</sup>

#### GERALDINE G. GOODE SCHOLARSHIP

One or more awards are given to undergraduate students entering 4<sup>th</sup> year in the School of Environmental Studies who demonstrate active, environmentally-related volunteerism within their community. **\*Additional Documents:** A cover letter (max 500 words) describing what led you to your volunteer activity, what did you learn from this involvement, and how will these skills/experiences benefit you in your chosen career path? Include a letter of support (max 350 words) from a supervisor of the volunteer activity.

#### RHYS ALEXANDER DAVIS SCHOLARSHIP IN ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES

No application required. Students are nominated by the School. One or more scholarships are awarded to academically outstanding undergraduate students in a declared Major or Minor in Environmental Studies based on the three following core courses: ES 301, ES 321, ES 341.

#### RYSZARD BORZUCHOWSKI SCHOLARSHIP

No application required. Students are nominated by the School. One or more scholarships are awarded to academically outstanding undergraduate students in a declared Major or Minor in Environmental Studies.

#### SELLEMAH SCHOLARSHIP

Students apply for this scholarship online, through Online Tools. One or more scholarships, totaling not more than \$1,000, will be awarded to academically outstanding undergraduate Indigenous (First Nations, Métis, or Inuit) students in the School of Environmental Studies. If no applicants meet this criteria, preference will be given to Indigenous students in the Faculty of Social Sciences.

### STEPHEN CANNING MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

One or more scholarships are awarded annually to students who have achieved academic excellence and are entering the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year of a declared Major in Environmental Studies, or in Writing, or to students in the Restoration of Natural Systems Diploma program. **\*Additional Documents:** A brief essay, 1-2 pages, illustrating a record of service and commitment to nature as well as a passion for communicating these interests and values. **DEADLINE:** April 30<sup>th</sup>

### VANCOUVER ISLAND TRAILS INFORMATION SOCIETY SCHOLARSHIP

One or more scholarships are awarded to academically outstanding undergraduate students entering 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year in a declared Major or Minor in Environmental Studies, who have completed an ES field school in the previous summer or winter session. **\*Additional Documents:** Applicants must submit a 1-page letter outlining how the material and teachings from their ES field school experience will assist in their future careers.

**DEADLINE:** This letter must be received by the School of Environmental Studies by **September 30<sup>th</sup>**. This scholarship may be awarded to a graduating student.

### VICKY HUSBAND SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship will be awarded to a student in a declared Major or Minor in Environmental Studies who has a record of outstanding volunteer contributions in environmental work. **\*Additional Documents:** A letter of recommendation from an organization providing evidence that the applicant has demonstrated exceptional contributions to environmental work as a volunteer. **DEADLINE:** April 30<sup>th</sup>
