

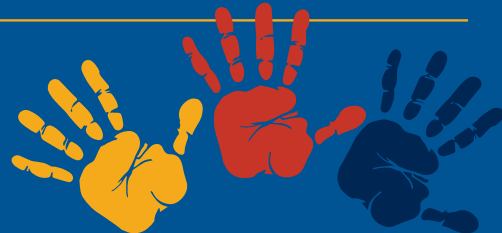

How can *GS 505: Research & Evaluation in Children, Youth & Family Services Policies* enhance your graduate journey?



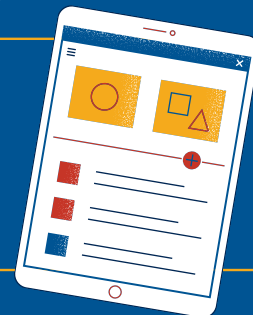
1) Learn text-based research skills that can be applied in graduate studies and featured on your CV
