The **Research & Innovation Scholarship for Engineering Aerospace Professionals (RISEAP)** is designed to support outstanding applicants entering the **Master of Engineering (MEng) in Aerospace Systems Engineering (ASE)**. This scholarship recognizes academic excellence, professional promise, and the diverse experiences needed to advance innovation in the rapidly evolving aerospace sector.

RISEAP aims to reduce financial barriers for highly motivated students while strengthening the breadth, creativity, and impact of the ASE graduate community.

Scholarship Value

- **Total value:** CAD \$6,000 – \$9,000
- One-time award, distributed during the three terms of the program

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Apply to and be admitted into the **MEng in Aerospace Systems Engineering (ASE)** program.
- Meet all academic admission requirements for the program.
- Be commencing studies in the upcoming Fall term.

Selection Criteria

RISEAP scholarships are awarded based on a **holistic assessment** of the applicant, including:

- **Academic Excellence**

Demonstrated strength in prior academic studies relevant to engineering, aerospace systems, or closely aligned disciplines.

- **Financial Need**

Consideration of the applicant’s ability to pursue graduate studies without financial support.

If financial assistance is needed, please include a brief 2–3 sentence explanation in your letter of intent.

- **Professional and Research Potential**

Evidence of interest in applied research, systems engineering, innovation, or emerging aerospace technologies.

- **Program Diversity and Impact**

Contributions to the intellectual, experiential, and professional diversity of the ASE program, including interdisciplinary backgrounds, non-traditional career paths, or underrepresented perspectives.

Why RISEAP?

The aerospace sector is undergoing rapid transformation driven by advanced systems integration, autonomy, sustainability, and space technologies. RISEAP supports emerging professionals who are prepared to engage with these challenges and contribute meaningfully to the future of aerospace systems engineering.

How to Apply

No separate scholarship application is required. All eligible applicants admitted to the MEng in Aerospace Systems Engineering program will automatically be considered for the RISEAP scholarship. That being said, we encourage all applicants to review the scholarship selection criteria prior to submitting their application.

Scholarship decisions will be made alongside admission offers.
