Footnotes:

- Students must complete Math 120 and/or ECS 100 where required. This will be determined upon admission and students will work with the ECS Launchpad Academic Advisor to develop a customized program plan to suit their needs.
- Students admitted to ECS Launchpad may target Engineering or Computer Science. Students who are unsure which program they wish to target should work with the ECS Launchpad Academic Advisor to develop a customized program plan which allows admission to either program.
- Students must complete both CHEM 150 or the approved substitute CHEM 101 and ENGR 141 as program requirements for BENG and must complete CHEM 150 or the approved substitute CHEM 101 as a program requirement for BSEng
- UVIC ENGR 141 is a BEng requirement, but not a BSEng program requirement. A student admitted to the BSEng program may use ENGR 141 credit to satisfy a [Technical Elective](#) requirement. UVIC PHYS 111 is a BEng requirement, but not a BSEng program requirement. A student admitted to the BSEng program may use PHYS 111 credit to satisfy a [Natural Science Elective](#) requirement.
