Period of employment is **September 1 – December 31, 2026**. Students **must be on campus** to fulfill TA responsibilities. **Total hours per position is 73**. The actual number of positions and/or hours is subject to funding availability and/or course enrolment or cancellation. Working hours per week can vary and the course instructor will provide guidance. Based on [University Policy No: HR6315 Specialist/Instructional Appointments](#), full-time students are normally limited to a maximum of 14 hours/week. **Priority is given to Civil Engineering graduate students.**

Training will be provided prior to entry of labs. For **new TAs, two hours** of your appointment will be allocated to cover mandatory training.
