

Proper Uses of Computer Science accounts:

Use of your computing account is a privilege to be exercised responsibly. In accepting an account issued by the Department of Computer Science, you are agreeing:

- 1. You are responsible for all activity on your account.
- 2. You will not tamper with the operating system security or accounting nor disguise your identity while using the system.
- 3. You will not permit any other individual to use your account.
- 4. You will not interfere with other users nor attempt to obtain access to another account.
- 5. You will not permit processes to accumulate excessive amounts of compute time or resources.
- 6. You will not modify the system configuration or install or save software other than programs you create as part of your course work.
- 7. You will not distribute or maintain material in violation of the university's <u>Discrimination & Harassment Policy (GV0205)</u>.
- 8. You will not store or display inappropriate items (for example: pornography).
- 9. You will not store large files that are unrelated to course work, for example: MP3 files, image files, etc.)
- 10. You will not copy proprietary software.
- 11. You will not use your computing privileges for commercial gain.
