We are pleased to announce that we will begin a new Masters in Art Education cohort in July.

An M.Ed. in Art Education at the University of Victoria offers an exciting experience that is unique in Canada because of our extensive studio focus. Students in the program are assigned their own space to work in a shared studio in each of the summers of the program.

Our M.Ed program is offered as a two-summer cohort program. This degree is a career credential intended for students who wish to develop their competencies in teaching studio-based art activities at the elementary and secondary school levels as well as in post-secondary institutions and community settings.

The program is designed to broaden and deepen the studio experience of students, to involve them in advanced art education studies, to develop research capacity in art education, and to focus on practical classroom applications. Individual creative exploration is emphasized in all courses.

Applicants must therefore have experience in art education and present a portfolio of personal artwork.
