



MEd in Art Education

We are pleased to announce that we will begin a new cohort in July 2025

An MEd in Art Education at the University of Victoria offers an exciting experience that is unique in Canada because of our extensive **studio focus**. Students in the program are assigned their own space to work in a shared studio in each of the summers of the program.

Our MEd program is offered as a two-summer cohort program with face-to-face studio intensive summers (2025-2026) and online coursework during the year. This degree is a career credential intended for students who wish to engage with art education theory and practice in K-12 schools and community settings while learning arts-based methodologies. The program culminates in a final project developed around each students' arts-based interests.

The program is designed to broaden and deepen the studio experience of students, to involve them in advanced art education studies, to develop research capacity in art education, and to focus on practical classroom applications. Individual creative exploration is emphasized in all courses.

Applicants must have experience in art education and present a portfolio of personal artwork.
