## MASTER OF EDUCATION Inclusive Worldviews and Compassionate Pedagogies



The Master of Education degree in Curriculum Studies: Inclusive Worldviews & Compassionate Pedagogies is designed for educators interested in learning how worldviews and identities inform our understanding of social justice issues (cultural sensitivity, power, voice, invisibility, representation, discrimination and privilege), which shape our teaching. Compassionate pedagogies encourage a more equitable balance of power related to gender, race, culture, religion, sexuality, class, and ability. Students complete 15 units of coursework on campus (7 courses plus graduating project) starting July 5-27, 2023. Program concludes by students developing an original graduating project based on their specific interest area.

Tuition: \$2,100 for each of 5 semesters (totally \$10,500).
