



MASTER OF EDUCATION IN EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

The Master of Education degree in early childhood education offers experienced educators a dynamic opportunity to work together in a two-year cohort. The courses in the program will focus on current issues and trends in early childhood education, and will address a range of theories and principles that guide early childhood studies. Students will conclude their programs by developing an original graduating project based on their specific area of interest in early childhood education.

Students will complete 15 units (7 courses plus graduating project) that will occur through two on-campus summer sessions (July), and two online winter sessions (September-April).

The program cost is approximately \$13,500 (spread over five installments).
