#### **Program admission requirements**

- 1. Admissibility to the university. Undergraduate Admissions Services determines eligibility for admission to UVic.
- 2. An acceptable undergraduate Bachelor's degree recognized by Undergraduate Admissions Services.
- 3 units of approved English literature (or English literature and academic composition).
- Demonstrated competency in written English (grade requirement; see page two).
- See the three grade point average (GPA) requirements described on page two.
- Approved academic studies in one or two teachable subjects relevant to the BC curriculum. A list of available subjects is provided on the website below.
- Applicants must satisfy the experience requirement described on the program website below. Eligible applicants may also be invited to attend an interview.
- For current applicant selection criteria, please see the program website below. This is subject to change for future intakes; please see the program website updated annually each fall for the upcoming intake.
