- We will accept up to 1 course (1.5 units¹) in cultural studies provided the course was taught in Spanish, not in English.

In addition to the required lower-level courses, you'll likely take SPAN (350A & 350B) or 349; SPAN (390 and/or 391); and SPAN 449 or (450A & 450B).
