POSITION: We are seeking one or two highly motivated and organized students to join our research team as Research Assistants (RAs). This project develops *Climate Grief Cafés*—community-based gatherings designed as supportive, sensory-friendly spaces for reflection, creative expression, and dialogue on climate change and broader world tensions. The RA(s) will play a key role in event planning, student and community engagement, and supporting group-based processes, as well as contributing to ethics applications and reporting.

BRIEF PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Climate Grief Cafés aim to create inclusive, welcoming spaces where UVic students and community members can gather to process emotions, share stories, and imagine hopeful futures. Rooted in resilience theory, the project highlights how collective reflection and creative expression contribute to emotional, relational, and community resilience. The cafés will be documented through video, art, and written reflections, with insights shared through a culminating community gathering and broader knowledge mobilization activities including produced music video viewing events.

- Conduct literature reviews and synthesize findings.
- Maintain organized project files and attend weekly research meetings.
