ED-D 480 A01 Contemporary Topics in Education: Leadership in Climate Justice

Course Description:

This course invites students to explore, understand, and critically engage with leadership responses to climate injustice, particularly as it affects historically marginalized communities—including Indigenous peoples, Black communities, and people of colour. In the face of the current climate crisis, students will be challenged to move beyond technical or managerial approaches and instead reimagine leadership through a justice-oriented lens.

Drawing on the knowledge, perspectives, and lived experiences of scholars, activists, and thinkers who contest the legacies of colonialism and modernity as root causes of climate injustice, students will engage in learning that centers ecological interdependence and systemic critique. Emphasis will be placed on speculative and worldbuilding practices that foster the imagination of alternative, just, and relational futures.
