Legacy Art Gallery

Co-op/Work Experience

Co-op is an optional addition to your degree that enables you to acquire knowledge, practical skills for employment and workplace experience.

Fine arts work experience program

Complete one or two work experience terms (four to eight months) of full-time, discipline-related work. Participation in this program is limited. You may transfer to a regular co-op program subject to the approval by the co-op coordinator.

Fine arts post-study internship program

Complete an internship placement after all of your course work has been completed and prior to graduation. Internships are normally of four months' duration. These internship placements may not be

applied toward the graduation requirements for any co-op or work experience program. Participation in this program is limited.

Work Study
