For those interested in Chamber Singers, please see the information below:

Open to undergraduate and graduate students from all faculties and departments.

An audition is required via video recording submission that includes the following:

- Introduce yourself and announce your specific voice type (soprano, bass-baritone etc.).
- Please sing several 7-note major arpeggios/broken triads, each one descending in pitch by semitones - starting from middle C - to display the lowest comfortable part of your range, and ascending in pitch by semitones - starting from middle C - to display the highest comfortable part of your range. Use a piano or keyboard for this exercise if it helps you.
- Prepare one verse of an Italian song of your choice, sung a cappella (unaccompanied).
- Prepare and recite (in German) the words of the German national anthem.
- Lastly, clap in rhythm the first musical phrase of the French-Canadian folk song 'Alouette'.
