This is a 3-unit studio course that meets 5 days a week from May 7th to June 2nd, each day from 1:00pm to 5:00pm.

The course serves upper-level students from a variety of disciplines and should appeal accordingly; it is often a final course to fulfill graduation requirements.

## **Submission Information:**

Applicants should hold an MFA or equivalent degree, be a practicing professional artist, and have a record of exhibitions. Candidates should send a letter of interest, current curriculum vitae, images of recent work (up to 20 jpegs on a disc, 1024 x 768 pixels, *or* a mixture of images & video, via YouTube or Vimeo link), an image list, and a course proposal. The course proposal should outline the course contents and aims in reasonable detail, but does not need to include a class-by-class syllabus.
