Fall Term (Sep-Dec)

ART 103 Foundation Drawing and Painting

1.5 units

One of four courses forming the foundation year for studies in Visual Arts, this course is divided into two modules. The drawing module introduces the methods, materials and concerns in contemporary drawing through studio exercises and projects. The painting module introduces contemporary painting through studio projects exploring fundamental elements, materials and concepts.

ART104 - Foundation Sculpture and Material Methods

1.5 units

One of four courses forming the foundation year for studies in Visual Arts, this course focuses on the processes and ideas associated with material technologies in the visual arts and with the practices of contemporary sculpture. Students explore a range of workshop and studio practices and theoretical issues.

ART105 - Foundation Photography and Video Art

1.5 units

One of four courses forming the foundation year for studies in Visual Arts. Focuses on the processes and ideas associated with the practices of contemporary photography and video art. Students explore a range of studio practices and theoretical issues

ART141 - An Introduction to Contemporary Art Photography

1.5 units

An introductory lecture and practical course focusing on the ideas associated with contemporary art photography. Through lectures introducing students to various practices of contemporary photographers and photography assignments, students gain insight into photography as an art practice within the field of contemporary art.

ART 155 - Living Artists, Living Art

0.75 units

Introduces today's contemporary art world through the study of presentations given by local, regional, national and international artists. Offers a conceptual framework for creating, observing and discussing art. Content varies as different artists will be presenting individual research each term.

This is a new course, which is co-taught with a continuing faculty member.

ART 261 Digital Media Arts

1.5 units

An introduction to concerns and methods in the contemporary practice of digital media in a computer lab environment including web development, audio and computer assisted design

Spring Term (Jan-Apr)

ART 103 Foundation Drawing and Painting

1.5 units

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ART 212 – Painting

1.5 units

An extension of Art 211.

ART 242 Photography

1.5 units

A continuation of 241, including both practical and theoretical aspects of digital and film-based contemporary art photography.

Applicants should hold an MFA or equivalent degree, be a practicing professional artist, and have a record of exhibitions and teaching experience.

- Please submit a letter of interest listing all courses that you would like to be considered for.
- Current CV
- Course outlines for any of the course sections you are applying for.

For new applicants:

- Submit letter of interest that includes a description of your approach to the course
- Current CV
- Up to twenty images and / or up to 5 min of time-based documentation
