Priority will first be given to graduate students enrolled in the department's graduate program, in accordance with <u>Appendix B Letter of Understanding #TA 1</u>. Relevant experience with the subject area is required. Experience with online/distance education, and the Brightspace platform is an asset for online courses. Hours will be approximately 5-10 hours per week.
