**TITLE: Research Assistant, Graduate level**

**Description & Project Title: Parent-Infant Sleep Ecology Study**

We are looking for a research assistant at the graduate level to conduct a scoping review and to set up an online survey that will examine parental division of infant care during the day and nighttime, parental-infant sleep characteristics, and parental psychosocial outcomes (mental health, relationship satisfaction). The research assistant will be supervised by Dr. Christine Ou at the School of Nursing.

**Who are we looking for:**

We are looking for a candidate with research training that is interested in supporting research on the health and well-being of families with young children. This work can be carried out remotely.

**Research Trainee Job Description Duties & Responsibilities**

The Research Assistant position will primarily assist with two studies (a scoping review and an online survey study). They will:

- Perform scoping review data extraction, quality appraisal, and synthesis,
- Assist with ethics application,
- Prepare and manage online survey on REDCap platform with assistance from UVic Research Computing Services,
- Assist with participant recruitment through social media (Instagram, Twitter, Facebook) and liaising with community organizations that support parents,
- Participate in the development of writing up the findings such as reports and publications, and
- Attend team meetings and assist with administrative support as required.

**Qualifications**

- Graduate student (MA or PhD) in a relevant discipline (UVic student preferred),
- Willingness to learn to learn and use new software and programs (e.g., REDCap, Covidence, Canva) to support research activities,
- Must have good communication and organizational skill, attention to detail, and ability to problem-solve,
- Strong writing skills for contributing to the development of manuscripts for publication, and
- Able to manage multiple responsibilities and tasks effectively.
