The School of Health Information Science at the University of Victoria has been providing innovative leadership in health informatics education, research and consulting for over forty years. The School was founded in 1981 and the programs developed at the School have included a BSc in Health Information Science, a combined BSc with computer science, as well as a MSc and a PhD in health informatics. In addition, the school has developed the only nursing informatics program in Canada (the double Masters degree in that area). To date there are now over 1200 graduates of the School who work in key positions nationally and internationally. The areas covered by the curriculum are ever expanding and we are working on new educational and research initiatives in areas such as data science, virtual health, mobile healthcare and more. In this presentation we will discuss where the School has been, our current perspectives and explore future opportunities for the School.
