

Frequently Asked Questions (on how to submit a paper for ITCH 2019)

Q. *I am the lead author on a paper, but another author on the paper will be presenting it. Do I need to register?*

A. Yes, both you and the presenter will need to register by November 10, 2018

Q. *What is the maximum length of the paper?*

A. Five pages of text with at most one page of graphics (graphics can be interspersed throughout the paper but must exceed no more than one page in total.)

Q. *Is there a charge for papers over the maximum length?*

A. Yes. Authors will be charged \$40 CAD for each extra page.

Q. *Is there a maximum number of papers I can submit?*

A. No, but there is a maximum number of papers you can present due to scheduling implications.

Q. *What is the maximum number of papers I can present?*

A. The number of papers you present is dependent on scheduling.

Q. *Are coloured graphics allowed?*

A. No, all graphics must be in black and white

Q. *Is there a required format for the references?*

A. As regards to the content, form and punctuation of the References, authors should follow the Reference examples shown in the author checklist and sample template provided.”
