|  | Use the word "Table" or "Figure" followed by the number, followed by a period, in bold |
|  | Position below figures, above tables |
| Equation | Equations |
|  | Indent: left 0.8 cm |
|  | Space: before 12 pt , after 12 pt |
|  | Number equations sequentially within parentheses |
|  | Position the number at the right margin on the lowest line of the equation |
|  | Refer to the equation within the text as, for example, "Eq. (1)" or "Eqs. (2) and (5)" |
| Footnote | Footnotes |

|  | Alignment: justify |
|  | If provided, the email address for the contact author must only be a footnote on the first page |

|  | Journal names must be abbreviated as shown in http://PubMed.gov |
|  | Web citations must give the URL of the web page and the date cited |

| Title* | Title - mandatory |
|  | Font: 20 pt |
|  | Alignment: centred |
|  | Space: before 24 pt, after 16 pt |
|  | A title must be provided |
| General Format | Instructions |
| Line spacing |  |
|  | Single line spacing |
| Page setup |  |
|  | A4 paper |
|  | Margin: top 5.5 cm , bottom 4.2 cm , left 4.3 cm , right 4.3 cm |
|  | No page numbers, headers, or footers |
| Fonts |  |
|  | Font: 10 pt roman for running text |
|  | Font: 10 pt sans serif or Courier for literal text |
|  | Use italic and bold in pre-defined styles and for emphasis only |
| Headings |  |
|  | Capitalize all words except for articles (a, an, the) and coordinate conjunctions (and, or, nor) |
|  | Capitalize any word at the beginning of a heading |

## Keep to a minimum

If more than $10 \%$ of the page, the footnote should be an endnote

## Footnotes should be numbered

## Endnotes

Endnotes precede the "References" section
Endnotes should be numbered
Endnotes should be preceded by the heading "Endnotes"
Tables and figures

## Refer to each figure or table in the text

Number tables sequentially without reference to their section in the text
Number figures sequentially without reference to their section in the text
Make no reference in the text to the position of a table or figure, e.g., "above" or "below"
Position the table or figure at the bottom or top of its respective page only
Centre the table or figure horizontally across the page unless several fit in the same area
Separate from the running text with two or more blank lines
Do not wrap text around a table or figure
Use no smaller than 8 pt. font for text within tables, 6 pt. font for text within figures
Use a bar to show the scale in those figures that require one

## Quality of illustrations

Do not use screen or web images having low resolution
Illustrations must be grayscale; they will not be printed in colour
