

## Island Health Proximity Access Cards

Please read this form in its entirety, complete it, sign it, and submit it with your application documentation.

For you to have a Consolidated Practice Experience (CPE) with the Island Health Authority, you are required to have **both** an Island Health Photo ID and Proximity (security) Access cards. You will not be allowed to enter into your CPEs without these new cards.

### Island Health Proximity Access Card Information:

The Security system at Island Health uses Proximity Access cards to enter secure areas. As a nursing student, you will need a Proximity Access (security) card for your practice placements. A **\$20 deposit** (included as part of your \$40 application cheque) is required for your card. When you return your card at the end of your last CPE (NURS 491), the \$20 deposit will be returned to you.

In order to create this ID, the School of Nursing will need you to send us an electronic headshot of yourself, in jpeg format. This photo must meet the following criteria:

- Head shot from your shoulders upwards
- Looking directly at the camera
- Neutral background
- Clear image
