The University of Victoria, Faculty of Humanities, Department of English invites expressions of interest regarding the following course:

ENSH 307- Effective Communication in Health Professions

Explores the production of clinical and professional health communication as applied across communication contexts and written, oral and visual formats. Topics such as: bias and self-reflexivity in clinical communication practice; effective organizational and leadership communication; issues in public health and crisis communication; health and media literacies; knowledge translation and science communication; and conducting profiles and assessments in diverse communities.

This new course explores applied health communication at interpersonal, organizational, mass and intercultural levels, and the roles of patients, care providers, researchers, communications professionals and publics in knowledge translation and community engagement processes. Students will learn to produce evidence-based messages and develop policies that address diverse audiences and that account for the social determinants of health and healthcare access. This course is intended for students looking to understand health communication as a field or to work in communication roles in clinical practices, health administration and information science, health policy, public health, social work or related fields.

This course counts towards a Minor and/or General in Professional Communication and can also be taken as a Humanities elective.

Qualifications for the position:

Preferably a PhD in Professional Communication, but applicants with an M.A. and a record of excellent teaching experience and/or relevant experience in health communication, public health, health policy, or health information science may be considered.
