PART-TIME MASTERS DEGREE PROGRAM IN ENGLISH AT THE UNIVERSITY OF VICTORIA

- www. As of September 2023, you can earn your Masters Degree in English by studying part-time at the University of Victoria.
- **THOW LONG DOES IT TAKE?** If you take one course each term, you can complete your MA in just two years.
- **DO I HAVE TO MOVE TO VICTORIA?** No! You can do the whole thing online if you choose. Online courses are offered every term, with guaranteed live discussion sessions in digital seminars led by world-recognized faculty. Live sessions will be scheduled in late afternoons and evenings (Pacific Time) to accommodate working students. Local students who are available for inperson graduate courses on campus may enrol for those.
- **THOW MUCH WILL IT COST?** You'll only pay part-time tuition* and save on ancillary fees, travel, housing, and moving costs associated with uprooting to come to Victoria for a year.
- TIS IT THE SAME DEGREE THAT IN-PERSON STUDENTS EARN? Yes! You'll earn the same degree as you would get by coming to Victoria and studying full-time for a year.
- WHAT DOES THE PART-TIME PROGRAM STRUCTURE LOOK LIKE? You'll take six graduate courses in a variety of topics, including a research methods and professional development course (ENSH500). In addition, typically in your final semester, you'll enroll for the graduating MA Essay/Project (ENSH598) in a topic of your choice, supervised by a faculty member.
- WHY IS THIS A GOOD IDEA? Doing your MA can improve your capabilities in teaching, make you eligible for promotions, enable you to change careers, and enhance your earning potential. It's also challenging, fun, and rewarding.
- **WHAT IS THE APPLICATION DEADLINE?** We accept applications on a rolling basis until the program is full: for September 2025 admission apply before 15th June 2025, and for January 2026 admission apply before 30 September 2025.
