I love being in control of my own schedule and earnings. It's very easy for me to spend weekends and evenings working, because the time and money are invested in my own corporation. Also, I can work from anywhere, and it's definitely motivating being able to work from a beach house in Tofino or a pool in Palm Springs! Plus, I love the range of industries my clients are in. It keeps the work exciting to be able to switch from Hollywood films to economic reports, and I've learned a lot from immersing myself in all these different sectors.
