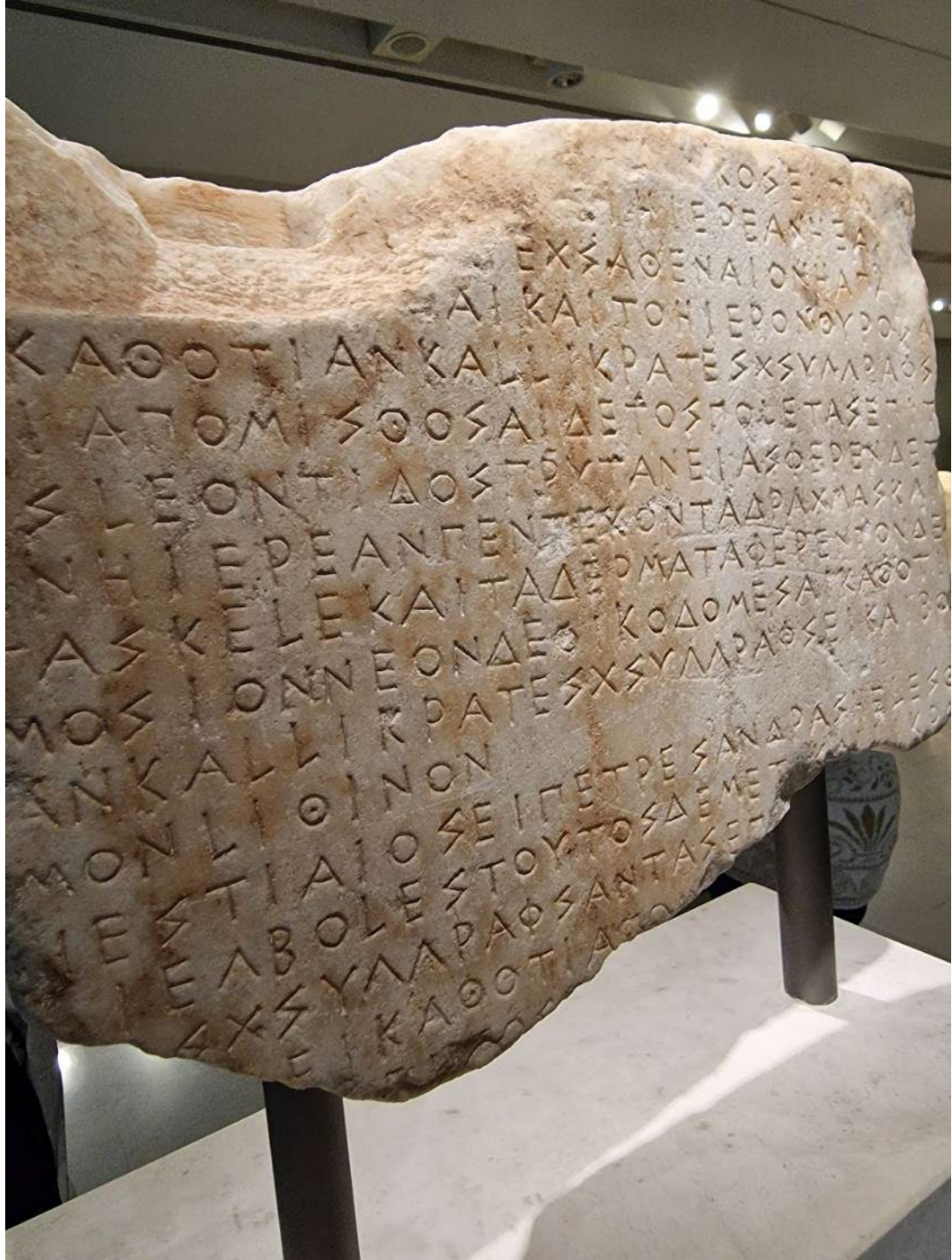




Greek 201: Advanced Greek Grammar

Greek 201 is the third instalment in the ancient Greek sequence. The course introduces the advanced grammar and vocabulary necessary to read ancient Greek, and features readings adapted from a variety of ancient Greek authors.

- advanced Greek grammar
- advanced Greek reading skills
- historical and cultural contexts of ancient Greek
