

## Greek 302: Greek Tragedy

Greek 302 is an advanced reading course in Greek after the introductory sequence. The course will involve translation and analysis of one or more plays of Aeschylus, Sophocles, and/or Euripides. Readings typically include reading two plays by different authors.

- historical and cultural contexts of ancient Greek tragedy
