

Greek 202: Introduction to Greek Literature

Greek 202 is the fourth instalment in the ancient Greek sequence. The course introduces the advanced grammar and vocabulary necessary to read ancient Greek, and features original readings from a variety of ancient Greek authors.

Learning Outcomes:

- a Greek vocabulary of about 650 words
- advanced Greek grammar
- advanced Greek reading skills
- historical and cultural contexts of ancient Greek
