Latin 225 is the second instalment in our revised Latin sequence. The course introduces the intermediate grammar and vocabulary that you will need to read Latin, and features readings inspired by Latin literature.

Learning Outcomes:

- a Latin vocabulary of about 550 words
- intermediate Latin grammar
- intermediate Latin reading skills
- historical and cultural contexts of Latin
