She is the author of numerous essays that explore the relationship between subjectivity, creativity, and literature, such as *Invulnerables e invertebrados: Mutaciones antropológicas del sujeto contemporáneo* (2022); seven novels, including *Cada noche, cada noche* (2016), which re-writes Lolita's story from a personal perspective; and short fiction collections. She is a commentator for *El País*, and a contributor to several literary magazines. She has been teaching creative writing for over two decades and has a long career as a feminist activist.
