HIST 2 – Research Assistant Dr. Lynne Marks

Conducting primary research on the history of second wave feminism in Canada, focusing on welfare rights, lesbian rights and immigrant women's activism from the 1970s and 80s. Research will include conducting archival and newspaper research as well as bibliographical research. It may also include conducting oral history interviews for this project. It will include uploading archival and interview material from this project to a project website and assisting with organizing online seminars on the history of welfare rights, Indigenous and immigrant women activists. If the candidate has skills in website design, they would also be involved in creating a website for this project.

QUALIFICATIONS: At least third year standing with a minimum of a B+ average, as well as upper level courses in Canadian History, Women's/Gender History and or Gender Studies required. Some experience with historical research required. Skills in website maintenance and website design would be ideal, but not required.
