Ms. Coninsx will discuss CETA, broader EU-Canada relations, the strategic partnership agreement - which has stalled over Canada's reluctance to include language on human rights and non-proliferation, and opportunities forresearch cooperation.

Ms. Coninsx began her posting as the EU's top diplomat in Canada in September 2013, after serving four years as Ambassador of the EU to Mexico. She has been an official in the EU since 1984; she started in Legal Services, and she later served as Minister-Counsellor at the EU Delegation in New York and thereafter in Geneva.
