PAAS 125: Introduction to Filipino I
Filipino Tagalog language instruction for beginning language students.

PAAS 126: Introduction to Filipino II
Continuation of 125, basic conversations and grammar in Tagalog and readings of a variety of elementary textual materials.

PAAS 225: Intermediate Filipino I
Continuation of 126, advanced sentence patterns (grammar) and use of written and audio-visual materials to stimulate students' ability to communicate.

PAAS 226: Intermediate Filipino II
Continuation of 225, advanced readings, schema exercises to facilitate vocabulary building and longer written assignments. Emphasis on listening, speaking, reading, and writing.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE: Demonstrated record of excellence in teaching Tagalog-based Filipino language at University level. Fluent Filipino is required, as is evidence of knowledge of the multicultural context of Philippine languages. Knowledge of a second Philippine language is desirable. PhD in L2 Linguistics or related field preferred.
