#### PAAS 116: Beginner Chinese I: Part 1

First half of Beginner Chinese I for students with no prior or very limited knowledge of Chinese. Basic skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing in Mandarin Chinese.

#### PAAS 218: Intensive Beginner Chinese II

Bringing beginner students to the lower-intermediate level in modern standard Chinese. Primary emphasis on reading and translation of texts in modern Chinese in both standard and simplified characters. Introduction of elements of the classical language as used in modern writing. Attention to listening, speaking, and writing skills.

### REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE:

Applicants should hold at least one graduate degree in the field of Chinese Studies or related field and have demonstrated record of excellence in teaching at the University level. Fluent or near-fluency in Chinese is required.
