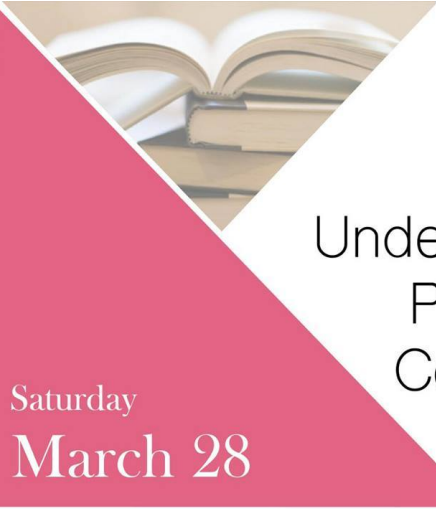

“Argumentation, Adversariality and Social Norms”

This paper/talk examines social norms that might prevent individuals from full and equal participation in arguments, drawing on Moulton and Hundleby’s critiques of the adversarial paradigm of philosophy. While this does not mean that adversarial debate ought to be eliminated entirely from the methodology of philosophy, it is suggested that, if diversity in philosophy is desirable, a greater pluralism in its methodology is required.
