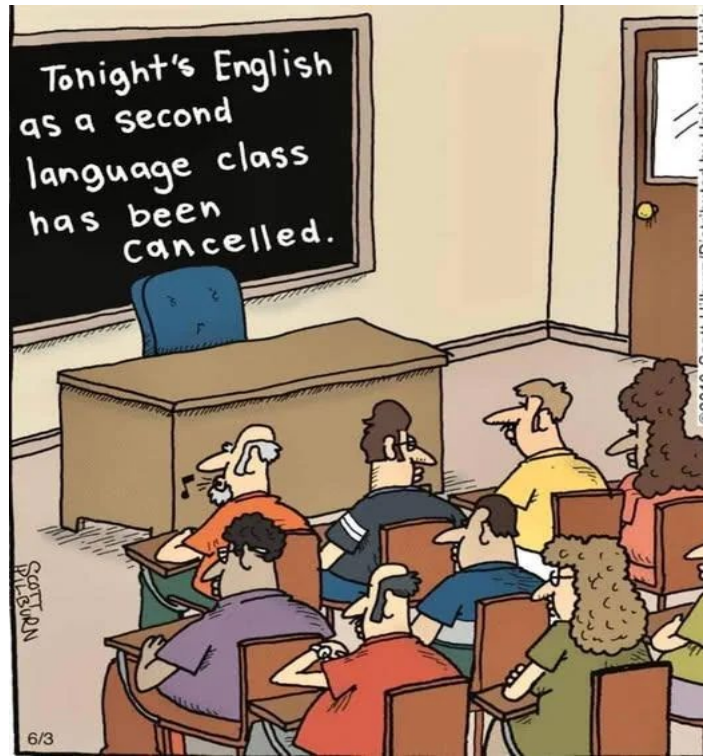




## GMST 108: Introduction to Translating German Texts (1.5 units) Spring 2027 – University of Victoria
