Prerequisites

This is an excellent course to explore European Studies. There are no prerequisites, but this course serves as a prerequisite for EUS/POLI 311 - Governments and Politics in Europe and one of the paths towards participating in the EU Study Tour.

Description

Examines the cultural, social, economic and political history of post-WWII Europe from an interdisciplinary perspective. Introduces key issues associated with the study of decolonization, European integration, migration and other important aspects that shaped the societies and cultures of modern Europe.

The course is team-taught. There will be two midterms, a final exam and a group project in which students create a short documentary/ video podcast.
