Prerequisites

Spanish 12, or Span 100B, or Span 149, or permission of the school. Not open to native or near-native speakers of Spanish.

Description

Participants will obtain writing, listening and communication skills at the A2 level of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). At the end of Span 250A, you will have completed half of the requirements necessary to become a user of Spanish at A2 level. The second half will be covered in Span 250B. The A2 student, according to the CEFR Global Scale, is considered a user that “Can understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to areas of most immediate relevance (eg. very basic personal and family information, shopping, local geography, employment). Can communicate in simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar and routine matters. Can describe in simple terms aspects of his/her background, immediate environment and matters in areas of immediate need”.

This course is taught mostly in Spanish.
