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Undergraduate Applicant, Admission and Arrival Patterns at UVic – Fall, 2004.

The following report describes the undergraduate applicant, admission and arrival patterns for the 2004/2005 academic year.

A total of 12,054 prospective students applied for Fall 2004 admission. Offers of admission were extended to 7,103 applicants who met the admissions cut-off approved by the VP Academic and Provost. Of those admitted applicants, 3,554 students accepted the offer of admission and registered in classes in the winter term. This translates to 2,857.1 new full-time equivalent (FTE) students.

For September 2004 admission, the University of Victoria set its admission cut-off for secondary students at 80% for admission to the Faculties of the Humanities, Social Sciences, and Science; compared to a cut-off of 81% for September 2003 admission. This admission cut-off was lowered to 78% as a result of an increased number of available spaces for incoming students.

As in previous years, the majority of registrants (59.9%) are female and more than half are aged 19 or younger with a mean age of 21.6 years. Eighty-five percent of our registrants held Canadian citizenship. Citizens from other countries include Asia and the Pacific Rim (6.2%), Europe and the Middle East (4.3%) and the rest of the Americas (2.3%).

Fifty-eight percent of our new students applied for entry with a secondary school credential, thirty-five percent with a post-secondary credential. The academic performance of new entrants this year was 85.2% mean GPA for secondary registrants, and 76.9% mean GPA for post-secondary registrants.

Yield rates

The key yield rate of Arrivals per Admission is down from last year (-3.0%) at 50%. Yield rates associated with FTEs have all increased compared to Fall 2003 due to the greater course-load that our new students are taking.

Notes to Tables One to Five

- 1 In Tables One to Four, applicants are defined as having entry points of September 2004 and a "U1" (undergraduate) application status. Admitted applicants are defined by the admission field on ISIS. Arriving applicants are those who were registered in one or more 2004/05 winter session units as at September 15, 2004. The number of arriving applicants does not reconcile exactly with IA registration statistics because this analysis includes only students with September 2004 entry points.
- 2 All discussions of "secondary averages" include only those applicants whose admission was based on that average (i.e. BCCUR, BCGRD, other secondary) and who had valid data; other applicants with valid secondary average entries were excluded. Similarly, "post-secondary averages" include only BCCOL, BCUNI and other post-secondary applicants with valid data.
- 3 Total applicant data for the Faculty of Law are not available on ISIS; only admitted and arriving applicant data are available. Tables Three and Four therefore exclude or limit Faculty of Law data. Stated applicant volumes (n=12,054) are therefore lower than actual by the unreported Law applications.
- 4 The calculation of FTE values involved minor estimation in some cases. For the University overall, and within each faculty, FTE estimation is within .5 percent of actual data (as at September 15).
- 5 Applicant ages are calculated as the age at December 31, 2004.
- 6 The "previous institution" field captures the most recently attended institution.
- 7 The source for all tables is the September 15/2004 IA download of ISIS.
