Canadian Immigration Documents



Immigration documents required to study in Canada

While you study at UVic:

- Study permit with **UVic named as the institution**
 - Blended-delivery programs will require a study permit for the **in-person/in-Canada components only**
 - Programs that are less than 50% in person are not PGWP-eligible
- Temporary resident visa (TRV) or Electronic travel authorization (eTA) (entry document)
- Co-op work permit (if applicable)

Changing Designated Learning Institutions (DLIs)

If you applied for your current study permit with a Letter of Acceptance from another institution you will need to apply for a new study permit to attend UVic.

As part of the application, you must include a letter explaining why you're changing schools. You should submit this application as soon as possible.

- If you do not receive your new study permit in time to start studies in May or September, you will need to change your point of entry. Contact your Admission Officer (UG) or graduate secretary (GR) to discuss your options.
- If you are currently holding a valid study permit to attend secondary school in Canada, you need to get a new study permit by [applying to extend](#) your current one to attend a post-secondary school. You can continue your studies at the post-secondary level while waiting for a decision on your new study permit application. If your study permit application is refused, you must stop studying immediately.
- Secondary school students, holding a visitor record will need to wait to receive their study permit before starting at UVic

Immigration documents for accompanying family members

Spouse/common law partner

- [Spousal Open Work Permit \(SOWP\)](#) or Visitor Record
SOWP only available to spouses/partners of students in select programs such as master's, PhD and certain professional degree programs at the undergrad level.
- eTA or TRV

Dependent children

- Study permit or Visitor Record
- eTA or TRV

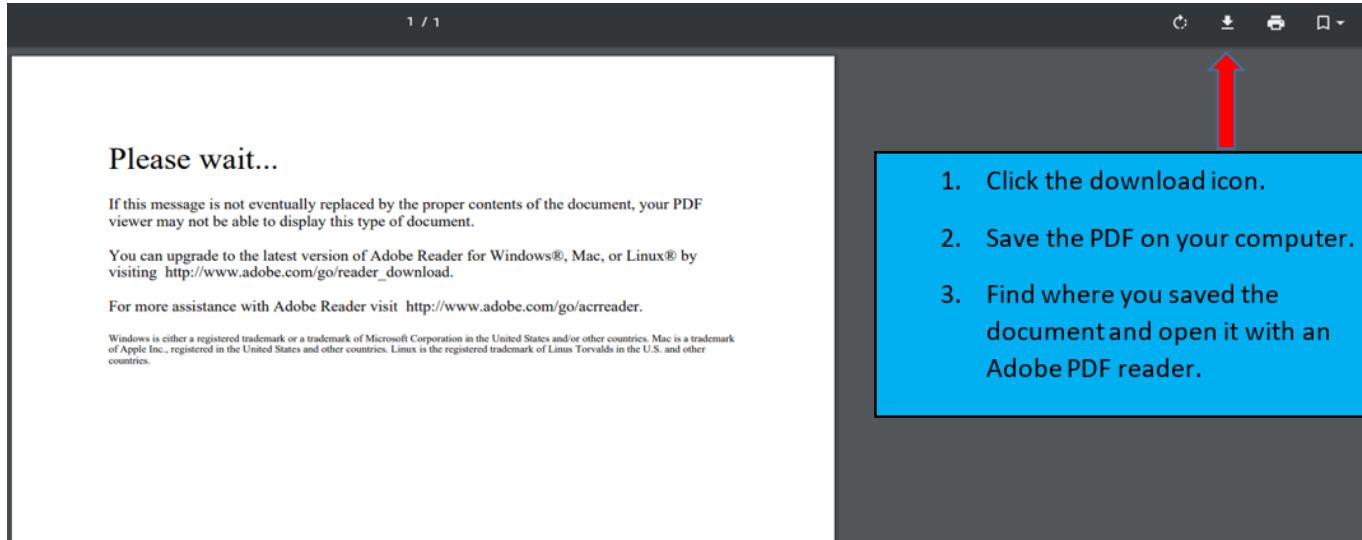

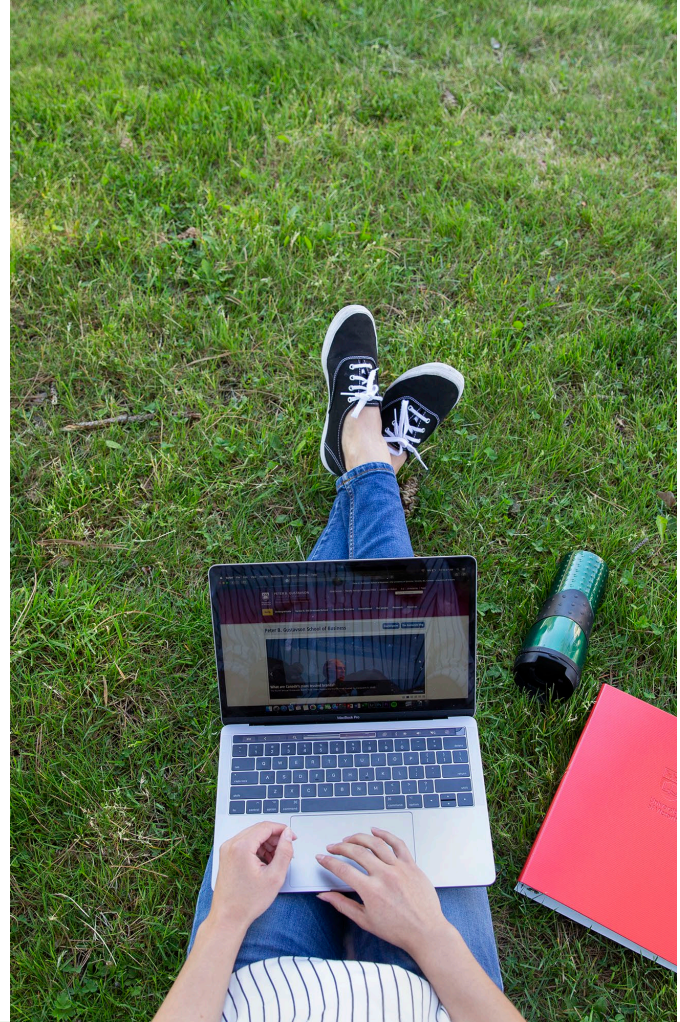

Your application to study in Canada has been approved. A permit authorizing your studies will be issued to you on your arrival to Canada following an examination by an officer of the Canada Border Services Agency, subject to your compliance with the requirements of the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* and its Regulations. The officer will ask to see this letter, your passport and may request to see your supporting documents, such as the letter of acceptance from your educational institution. Do not pack these or other valuable papers in your checked luggage. You can find out more about which documents you will need to bring with you by visiting www.cic.gc.ca/english/study/study-arriving.asp

As you gather your documents, please take note of the following:

- **This letter is not a passport or travel document.** You will not be permitted to board your flight without your passport, even if you have this letter with you.
- **This letter is not an authorization permitting you to enter or remain in Canada.** An officer of the Canada Border Services Agency will make that determination upon your arrival to Canada.
- **This letter is important** because it contains information that will be used by the Canada Border Services Agency to issue your study permit. Please do not misplace it.

You must seek entry to Canada to obtain your study permit by 2018/03/21 (yyyy/mm/dd). Your passport must be valid beyond the period you intend to remain in Canada. If not, the validity of your study permit will not be issued beyond the expiry date of your passport, or, for United States citizens and permanent residents, the validity date of your identity document.

Note: As an international student in Canada, it is your responsibility to ensure that you continue to meet the conditions of your study permit, including the requirement to actively pursue studies. Your study permit will automatically become invalid 90 days after you complete your study program, regardless of the expiry date indicated on your study permit. For more information, please consult:

If you are from a country/territory which **requires** a temporary resident visa (TRV) (<http://www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/visas.asp>), you have also been issued a visa. This visa has been affixed in your passport, and is valid for multiple visits to Canada until it expires. If you obtain a new passport before your visa expires, you will need to apply for a new visa. You may do so by visiting: www.cic.gc.ca/english/information/applications/visas.asp

Other than United States citizens, if you are from a country/territory which does **NOT** require a temporary resident visa (<http://www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/visas.asp>), and you are a permanent resident of the United States, you have also been issued an Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA). Your eTA is valid for multiple visits to Canada, until (yyyy/mmdd). Your eTA number is (yyyyymmdd) and is linked to the passport you used when you applied to study in Canada. If you obtain a new passport before (yyyy/mmdd), you will need to apply for a new eTA by visiting www.canada.ca/eTA

If you are a United States citizen, you are **not** required to obtain an eTA or a TRV. United States citizens who do not have a passport may obtain their United States birth certificate or certificate of naturalization. United States permanent residents entering Canada from the United States may present their alien resident "green" card instead of a passport.

In some provinces or territories, students must also have public health insurance. You must ensure that you and any dependents have adequate health care insurance or financial resources to cover possible contingencies. Further information is available from the ministry of health of the province or territory in which you intend to study.

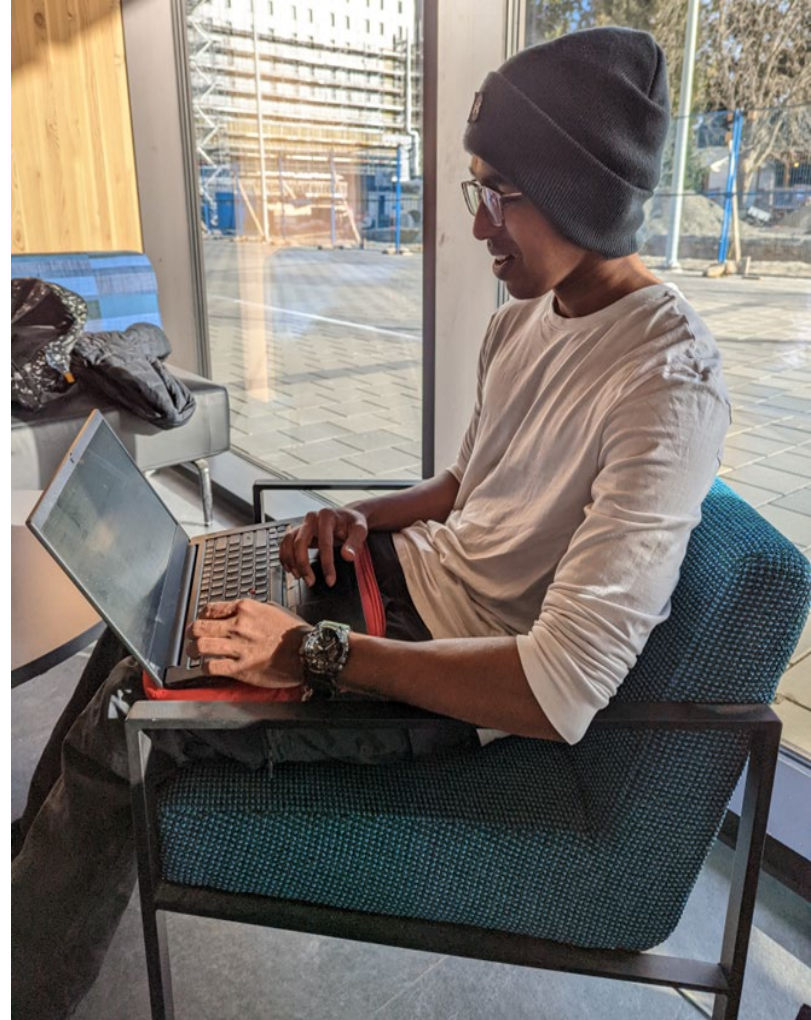
