




# Working in Canada as an International Student

# What Do I Need to Work in Canada



### Working while studying in Canada:

- Study Permit Work Authorization Privilege
- Co-op/internship Work Permit
- Other open work permits

### **Work Permit exemptions:**

- Working from outside Canada or working for an overseas company outside Canada remotely.
- Some volunteer positions in Canada. (note: definition of "work" is not solely based on compensations)





### Working on and off campus




Your study permit may allow you to work while studying in Canada if you meet all the following conditions:

- You have started your program and are registered in **full-time** studies during regular academic sessions
- Your study permit has clear employment remarks stating your work eligibility
- You have a Social Insurance Number (SIN)



# Full-time Definition for UG Students

- Minimum 6 units in a 4-month term
- Minimum 12 units in fall term and spring term combined (Winter session)
- Enrolled in a 4-month Co-op term






## Sample Study Permit

Your study permit should have UVic named as your institution before you start your study in September unless you meet exemptions in place

### Allowable working hours

- Up to 24 hours per week off campus during regular academic sessions
- Unlimited hours on-campus during regular terms

**Regular terms** (Fall terms and Spring terms or summer sessions if you are required to register in summer sessions)

#### Scheduled breaks in-between 2 full-time terms

Unlimited hours on- and off-campus during scheduled breaks

# UVic co-op and experiential learning

#### If co-op, internship, or practicum is part of your program

 You need to have a co-op work permit before you can start your experiential learning

#### If co-op is optional, follow the steps below

You must

- 1. Apply to be accepted by Co-op program at UVic.
- 2. Obtain a letter from respective Co-op Office to apply for a co-op work permit, you must have a co-op/internship work permit in addition to your study permit when you commence your experiential learning activity.

#### If your course requires experiential learning

 Contact ICS to assess your co-op/internship work permit requirement. Your instructors do not have the licensing or training to assess your need for a student work permit for experiential learning.
