Description

This course examines ecological governance within Indigenous territories through Indigenous laws, including the individual and collective responsibilities towards lands and waters placed upon Indigenous citizenries through their respective legal orders. It takes a trans-systemic approach, as both Cree and Anishinaabe law will co-center the course, with support from other respective Indigenous legal traditions. It also necessarily explores the interaction of Indigenous environmental laws with Canadian-state law. This course will engage in questions of Indigenous environmental justice, co-management agreements, Aboriginal rights and title, gender and Indigenous laws, treaties, and the impact of Crown regulatory frameworks on Indigenous ecological governance.

Course Objectives/Outcomes:

- Engagement with ecologies of Indigenous territories and the legal relationships within them, including with lands, waters, flora and fauna.
- Identification and evaluation of the intellectual and practical challenges of the maintenance and reclamation of ecological governance through Indigenous legal orders.
- Identification of Indigenous legal theory and methods of engagement with Indigenous legal orders.
- An understanding of critical questions about environmental management within Canada and Indigenous laws within this management.

Course Evaluation:

Special Topic Presentation – 20%
Final Research Paper/Project – 50%
