

PhD Candidacy Exam External Examiners Nomination Form



The PhD student must discuss possible dissertation examiners with their two supervisors and agree on a list of three nominees. The potential examiners' names and contact details must be listed below and submitted to the Graduate Program assistant no less than six weeks prior to the proposed exam date.

Students and supervisors must not approach any of the nominees directly about the thesis or the student's program until after the examination process is complete.

Our preferred practice is that the examiner be a member of the University of Victoria, Faculty of Graduate Studies and be available on campus at the time of the exam. The examiner may be a member of the Law Faculty; the only limit is that he or she, of course, cannot be a member of the committee.
